## Challenges and Opportunities of Community Participation in Community Policing A Case of Dodoma Municipality in Tanzania

The study focused on investigating challenges and opportunities of community participation in community policing in Dodoma municipality, Tanzania. The study objectives were to identify the practice of community policing in the case study, examine community participation in community policing and determine the opportunities of community participation in community policing. The study used stratified, cluster and purposive sampling to select respondents to be interviewed. Interviews and questionnaire techniques were used to collect data.
